Deutzerhof Altenahr Eck Spätburgunder GG 2021

TA 6.1 g/l, RS 0.5 g/l

Deep aromas of black cherry, ripe damson plum and blackcurrant. Intense and grippy, with eye-watering linearity and long salty thread to keep the supple palate in line. Elegant barrel influence. Beautiful, complex and finely poised. Firmly rooted in place and style. As always, a true distance runner. (PS)

Deutzerhof Recher Herrenberg Frühburgunder GG 2021

TA 5.4 g/l, RS 0.5 g/l

Smells like blackberry fruit, spice, wild strawberry, roses. Darker and less luminous than in past years with no less intensity. Elegant vegetal notes of red bell pepper and wet autumn leaves. A tightly coiled stony thread pulls the creamy palate together. Rustic spice on the long finish. (PS)

Deutzerhof Neuenahrer Kirchtürmchen Spätburgunder GG 2021

TA 5.7 g/l, RS 0.5 g/l

Wild cherry, rosemary accents, dried leaves. Medium concentration, still somewhat light-bodied, zippy acidity and long finish. Even while it appears at first open, the mid palate puts up a firm stop sign for now. Delicate grip and red-fruit finish. (PS)

Deutzerhof Heimersheimer Landskrone Spätburgunder GG 2021

TA 6.3 g/l, RS 0.5 g/l

One of the few VDP estates far enough away from the river that it was not significantly affected by the floods. Piquant notes of wild strawberry and redcurrant, candied hibiscus and subtle toast. High-toned nuances of rosemary and spruce. Sleek and concentrated with fine-boned tannins, bright acidity, and a long spicy finish. The freshness and complexity are nearly irresistible. (PS)

Deutzerhof Mayschossener Mönchberg Spätburgunder GG 2021

TA 6.1 g/l, RS 0.5 g/l

Spicy aromas of pepper and cardamom, wild sage and bay leaf. Spicy from start to lingering finish. Black-fruit purity delivers light to an otherwise dark firmly structured body. Tangy acidity and long blackcurrant finish. Nimble and almost playful in its nuanced expression. (PS)
